### Customs data improvements

With changes in Worldwide tariffs and the majority of customs data now being sent electronically, providing more detailed commodity codes may help smooth the clearance of your items through customs and reduce the risk of items being detained.

In this release we're providing features to support this as well as make it simple to maintain the more complex codes.

#### HS codes

HS Codes may now be maintained in "Data > HS Codes". To get you started we've included all the HS Codes on your products and although we've brought across the original description, you may edit as desired.

The Commodity Code contains the HS Code together with the a two or four digit customs system specific extension related to the destination country.

As the Commodity Code is at a more detailed level than HS code it's perfectly valid to have more than one Commodity Code sharing a HS Code, for example, the composition of a fabric may alter the system specific extension although having the same HS Code.
